Psychologist Named To Staff



A young man named Stephen Hayes thinks Lynn residents should consider having mental check-ups at least once a year and furthermore he is going to try to do something about it.

Mr. Hayes is the new Psychologist at the Lynn Community Health and Counseling Center. He started working full time last week and he has some innovative ideas to introduce to the community.

Steven Hayes lives in Salem and for the past three years he has given therapy to patients at Danvers State Hospital. He has done research and trained staff members in Danvers for the State Dept. of Public Health.

Hayes philosophy is preventive medicine; mental breakdowns and depression can be prevented by check-ups and counselling before the problems that bother citizens overwhelm them.

The duties of the local Psychologist include offering neighborhood residents individual and group therapy, assessing the mental health needs of the residents, working with task force volunteers and coordinating all activities with the Administrator, William Mantzoukas.

The Health Center is expected to service 500 residents in the Second Action Year.
